



The Government of Kenya through the **Ministry of Sports, Culture and the Arts** in collaboration with the **Local Organizing Committee for IAAF World Under 18 Championships 2017 (WU18-2017)** established under the gazette notice No.5557 invites tenders from eligible bidders to carry out **Proposed Improvement Works for International Association of Athletics Federations (IAAF) Under 18 Championships 2017** at Moi International Sports Centre, Kasarani as follows-;

There shall be a Mandatory Pre-tender site visit on Friday, 28th April, 2017 FROM 10.00 AM at Moi International Sports Center-Kasarani. All interested bidders are required to attend.

Interested Contractors who are registered in relevant trades and categories, (proof of registration required) may obtain Tender Documents from **The event Liaison office, Moi sports complex-Kasarani (Sports Kenya HQS-Ground floor)** in person and a non-refundable fee of **Kshs. 1000/-** is to be paid in cash **at the Cash Office before 4.00pm on normal working days or in banker's cheque payable to The CEO WU18 Championships.**

Interested bidders should note that only those meeting the criteria indicated below as a minimum, supported by relevant documents at submission will be considered for further evaluation.

1. Proof of works of similar magnitude and complexity undertaken in the last five years.
2. The Bid Bond must be in form of Bank Guarantee from a reputable bank or approved insurance company.

3. Adequate equipment and key personnel for the specified types of works.
4. Sound financial standing and /or adequate access to bank credit line equal to at least 10% of their Tender Sum.
5. Litigation History of the Company (both court and arbitration cases).
6. Confidential Business Questionnaire.
7. Tax Compliance Certificate.
8. An undertaking in the form of a letter signed by the bidder stating that the firm will comply with the statutory requirements on Gender, Youth and Persons with Disabilities.

Further, tenders from the following tenders shall be treated as non-responsive and therefore subject to automatic disqualification:

- (i) A tender from a tenderer whose on-going project(s) is/are behind schedule and without approved extension of time.
- (ii) A tender from tenderers with on-going project(s) exceeding four (4) in number, regardless of the total value of the outstanding works.
- (iii) A tender from a tenderer who has been served with a default notice on on-going projects(s) or a tenderer who has been terminated in a Government Contract in the past.

Submitted bids will be opened publicly in the **LOC Boardroom, 1st Floor** soon after the above stated closing date and time in the presence of the tenderers or their representatives who choose to attend. Late bids will not be accepted.

Prices quoted must be net inclusive of VAT and all Government Taxes and must remain valid for one hundred twenty (120) days from the opening date of the tender.

The Bid Security, which must be from **a reputable bank or from a PPRA accredited insurance company**, shall be valid for one hundred fifty (150) days from tender opening date.
